

Provides coverage to an Insured against loss if the boundaries described in the endorsement are not contiguous as described and if there are any strips, gaps or gores separating the contiguous boundaries.

ENDORSEMENT

The Company insures against loss or damage sustained by the insured by reason of:

- (1) the failure of the _____ boundary line of Parcel A of the land to be contiguous to the _____ boundary line of Parcel B; or
- (2) the presence of any gaps, strips or gores separating any of the contiguous boundary lines described above.

This endorsement is issued as part of the policy. Except as it expressly states, it does not (i) modify any of the terms and provisions of the policy, (ii) modify any prior endorsements, (iii) extend the Date of Policy or (iv) increase the Amount of Insurance. To the extent a provision of the policy or a previous endorsement is inconsistent with an express provision of this endorsement, this endorsement controls. Otherwise, this endorsement is subject to all of the terms and provisions of the policy and of any prior endorsements ~~to it~~.
